




Facts Of Eurajoki Municipality

- Two power plant units in operation,
 OL3 in use March of 2023
- Interim storage for spent nuclear fuel, a repository for low and medium-level waste
- Disposal for spent fuel will be in operation in 2024–25. The first place in the world
- Active and dynamic many-sided electricity producing municipality

Safety and security

Trust and local acceptance

- Local level acceptance plays a key role when selecting the site for nuclear facilities. A long time is needed for acceptance and it is helpful if municipality in question has already nuclear facilities.
- Locally (in nuclear municipalities) people are much better informed about nuclear issues than at national level – communication has been ongoing since the power plants were commissioned (over 40 years).
