# Land and Spatial Development Board

The Estonian Land and Spatial Development Board (or MaRu) is a competence center for land and spatial planning, which provides a better living environment in both cities and the countryside.

Started on 1 January 2025.

Merged the Land Board (except geology), the Agricultural and Food Board (land improvement), the Ministry of Climate e-construction, the Ministry of Regional Affairs and Agriculture local government planning approval, and the planning register

We are doing this for the first time in Estonia - the State is also planning a nuclear power plant for the first time.


